George Sikorski, MAI, AI-GRS

Mr. Sikorski began his appraisal career with Hogan & Farwell Inc. from 1965 to 1977 where his assignments involved the preparation of both residential and commercial appraisals throughout the country. From 1977 to 1980 he managed the commercial real estate appraisal department for L.J. Sheridan Company. Mr. Sikorski was self-employed from 1980 to 1986 as a commercial real estate appraiser with assignments throughout the country.
